

Best of all, expect to recoup 60%-90% of your costs as your home increases in value.













05 Reinventing a Room

LIGHT AND BRIGHT KITCHEN






FRENCH DOORS

Ooh la la! French doors are never out of style! For a classic ever-chic and charming element for your home, replace old, dingy, or boring doors with timelessly fashionable French doors.














05 WINDOW SEAT

EXPOSED BRICK


The modern industrial look took commercial spaces by surprise in 2016. The penchant for this rustic style continues on in 2017 and hits home for private residences!



Scratched: Recipes From Scratch

OLD-FASHIONED PANCAKE

INGREDIENTS:

- * 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- *31/2 teaspoons baking powder
- *1 teaspoon salt
- * 1 tablespoon white sugar
- * 11/4 cups milk
- ***** 1 egg
- * 3 tablespoons melted butter

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. In a large bowl, sift together the flour, baking powder, salt, and sugar.
- 2. Make a well in the center and pour in the milk, egg and melted butter.
- 3. Mix until smooth.
- Heat a lightly oiled griddle or frying pan over medium-high heat.
- © Pour or scoop the batter onto the griddle, using approximately 1/4 cup for each pancake.
- 6. Brown on both sides and serve hot.
